

Umbrella Operation

OPENING

- 1 - Unlock storage cabinet (if you have one).
- 2 - With the removable handle loosen the **Lock Nut** (the lower of the 2 nuts), ease the canopy from the cabinet and remove straps, Position the umbrella over a clear area and tighten the **Lock Nut**.
- 3 - Move the handle to the **Winch Nut** (upper nut) and wind the canopy up. It should be clicking.
- 4 - The central hub MUST be wound up wrapping onto the upper tube, very important.

CAUTION: If your umbrella shows resistance, check that the canopy or arms are not catching on something. Do not use undue force to raise it. Check with us if in doubt.

CLOSING

- 1 - Place your handle on the **Winch Nut** with the handle grip at the bottom, pull the handle towards you slightly, press the **Release pin** all the way in and keep it there, now wind back the other way lowering the canopy while holding the pin in until the umbrella cover is closed. **Do not press this button when going up.** Take care to stand away from the handles swing when coming down. Once the arms are vertical stop winding immediately. Over winding will eventually wear the cable.
- 2 - Walk around and pull the fabric out from between the 8 arms.
- 3 - Replace the straps around the canopy and adjust until it's tight.
- 4 - Release the lower **Lock Nut** and swing the canopy into the cabinet.
- 5 - Tighten the lower **Lock Nut** so it can't move and store the handle away.

CAUTION: This umbrella is not to be opened during strong winds (50km +).

It's recommended that it be lowered while unattended or overnight in high winds.

If the canopy is in the lowered position, always ensure that the lock nut is in the locked position and the straps are wrapped around it after you have pulled the fabric out from between the arms.

Never lower or raise your umbrella with anyone underneath it.
